Provision for online learning platforms and resources that cater for learners with inclusive learning needs.			
Access to student-friendly online instructional aids and assessment tools, to facilitate the planning of collaboration and group work.			
Provision for an online learning environment that supports autonomous learning and student engagement.			
Access to online assessment tools/platforms that support ongoing feedback and formative assessments in the IBDP.			
Access to online assessment tools/platforms that support the IBDP exam paper format in different subjects.			
Measures to ensure the personal autonomy of the teachers as a part of ongoing organisational culture.			
A system-wide approach to address the well-being of students and teachers.			
An organisational plan to address the well-being of the school leaders.
